

FANTATENNIS 2025 BY TENNIS-POINT GAME MODE

1) PREDICTIONS

For each week of play, 30 in total, 8 tennis players must be selected from the scheduled tournaments (Max 4). The selection of 8 players must also be made in the Monte Carlo week where there is only one tournament.

The selection must be made by choosing:

2 among the seeds 1-4 who, to bring points, must reach at least the semi-final, upon reaching this threshold the points foreseen by the tournament will be counted, in the event of previous elimination the points missing to reach the semi-final will be subtracted
ES Djokovic (1) loser in the slam final is still worth 1300 points but if he goes out in the quarterfinals he brings a penalty of 400 points or the difference between the 800 theoretical points of the semi-final and the 400 actually won by the tennis player in the tournament.

2 among the 5-8 seeds who will have to reach at least the quarter-finals to bring points, upon reaching this threshold the points foreseen by the tournament will be counted, in case of previous elimination the points missing to reach the quarter-finals will be subtracted.
ES Berrettini (7) loser in the slam semifinals is still worth 800 points but if he goes out in the round of 16 he brings a penalty of 200 points or the difference between the 400 theoretical points of the quarter-finals and the 200 actually won by the tennis player in the tournament.

4 not included among the first 8 seeds who brings the points actually won in the tournament without risk of penalty.

For each week in which both ATP and WTA tournaments are played there is an obligation to select at least 2 male and 2 female players under penalty of nullification of the prediction.

This obligation obviously lapses in the weeks in which only one circuit is played.

The score assigned to the players is the official one of the scoreboards of the week. The scoreboards can be downloaded from the official website of the game www.fantatennis.net and from the official websites of the ATP and WTA www.atptour.com and www.wtatennis.com.

The choice of any players who are still involved in the qualifications is at the participant's sole risk and peril. It is not possible to indicate substitutes. If eliminated in the qualifications, the chosen players will get 0 points.

The Wild Card Player and the Big Card Player will be drawn as soon as the last scoreboard in the competition is published on social media or, if necessary, before the scoreboards are released. The draw will be filmed and posted, even if not live, on the YouTube video channel.

For the wild card player draw, the drawn scoreboard line or the position in the entry list ranking will be taken into account, while for the big card player, the number of the seed (from 1 to 4) will be taken into account based on the ranking drawn on the Monday before the draw.

In case of excessive delay, the organization may decide to cancel the tournament to give participants enough time to make their predictions.

2) 1000 GOLD, WILD PLAYER, BONUS PLAYER, WANTED PLAYER AND RELATIVE BOUNTY.

The WILD player: Every week a player or player from a board will be drawn who will be defined as WILD player. This player, if chosen, will double the score, even a negative one, obtained. The Wild player can be chosen as a Bonus but cannot be included in the 1000 gold. The maximum multiplier is x4.

In addition to the wild player, participants will have the opportunity to choose a master 1000 combined, male or female, in which to double the points of the tennis players of the chosen category, even negative and zero points are doubled with the only exception of the bounty points and bounty killer points which will not be doubled. The use of this option will be signaled by a yellow box next to the name of the participant in the prediction sheet. The tournaments on which the option can be used are Indian Wells, Miami, Madrid, Rome, Toronto/Montreal and Cincinnati. The doubled points will also be valid for the special rankings.

The BONUS player: During the season with the exception of the slams, each participant will have a chance to choose a player, necessarily seeded in a tournament, who will double the score, only positive and greater than 0, obtained. For example, a player seeded 1-4 chosen in a thousand who loses in the eighths will not go negative but will double the positive points made. This option when used will then be indicated with a green square in the prediction sheet. If not used during the season, the BONUS option will serve to double the points accumulated in the ATP Finals of the ranking path by the paired player.

The Bonus player cannot be played in the tournament chosen as 1000 gold.
The maximum multiplier is x4.

The Bounty is a point award for the unseeded player in the tournament, so for example outside the 32 seeds of a slam who eliminates a player among the top 4 seeds.
The WANTED will be drawn among the top 4 seeds of a weekly tournament, and will allow the unseeded player who eliminates him to earn a variable score based on the following table.

BOUNTY KILLER BONUS

This bonus is awarded to unseeded players of the tournament if they manage to eliminate in the first two rounds, a seeded player included among the top 16
The score varies based on the following table.

Bounty points and Bounty killer points are not doubled by the bonus, wildcard and 1000 gold options.

For example, a non-seeded player who is wildcard and eliminates the ts n 1 in the first round or in

the second round on which the bounty hangs in a slam losing in the quarterfinals gets
400 X2 = 800 points doubled for the wildcard option
1000 of Bounty
500 of Bounty
for a total of 2300 points.

If the unseeded team has no option that doubles the score in the example would be 1900 points.

IMMUNITY BONUS

Each participant in the game will have a chance to avoid the negative in slam tournaments only by using the immunity bonus in one of the seeds. Using this bonus, valid only in slams and for only one time per season, the chosen seed will take the points made in the tournament without the risk of going negative.

3) EXTRA BONUS

If a participant achieves the best score for three consecutive weeks, he will be rewarded with the possibility of being able to take advantage of a second bonus option during the season. It will not be possible to obtain more than one additional bonus option for each participant.

The participant who finds himself in the position of achieving the best score for 5 or more times will be entitled to an additional bonus of 3000 points.

The participant who finds himself in the position of achieving the best score for 10 or more times will be entitled to an additional bonus of 7000 points.

The two bonuses are cumulative and can lead to a total bonus of 10,000 points.

4) DELAYS

Delays will not be allowed in the 2025 season. Failure to submit the prediction by the deadline, normally one hour before the start of the first match on Monday, will automatically result in non-participation for the current week.

Between the publication of the last scoreboard and the start of the first match there must be at least 10 hours. If this time frame cannot be guaranteed, the deadline will be postponed to the end of the first day of competition.

It is the responsibility of each participant to send the prediction by the deadline. Any delays due to connection malfunctions will not be justified under any circumstances.

The organization will, when compiling the calendar, skip tournaments that usually draw with a delay of one day (e.g. Wta 500 Stuttgart). In the event of delays in the draw, a tournament may be cancelled if the scoreboard is not drawn by midnight local time on the second day before the deadline for predictions. (For tournaments that start on Monday, the deadline is midnight local time on Saturday). Cancellation of tournaments is not possible for Slam and 1000 tournaments.

5) INCOMPLETE OR WRONG PREDICTION

If an incomplete prediction is submitted, all missing players, even in the seeded brackets, will be considered eliminated in the first round and the relevant penalty will be applied.

In the event of an error in the prediction:

If one or more seeds are inserted in place of a non-seeded player, the excess seed(s), the last named in the lineup, will be inserted in the non-seeded slots and considered eliminated in the first round with the relevant penalty applied.

If one or more non-seeded players are inserted in place of the seeded players, the excess non-seeded players, the last named in the lineup, will be inserted in the seeded slots and considered eliminated in the first round, receiving the penalty. The slots will be filled starting with the seeds 1-4, then 5-8, then non-seeded players.

If a player is not entered in the draw, due to an error in filling out the message or due to a change in the technological equipment, both in the seeded and non-seeded slots, he/she will be considered eliminated in the first round, thus applying the negative score in the event of an error in the seeded slots to which the player belongs. Example error on a 1-4 in a slam is worth -800 points in the men's 400 for an incorrect 5/8 seed

6) FORECAST AND POSSIBLE CHANGE

To make predictions, the online form on the Fantatennis live page of the website www.fantatennis.net must be used. You must first register in the registration form and only after registration is complete use the prediction form. The deadline will be communicated at the time of the draw of the wildcard player and size on both the telegram group, easily accessible from the game website, and on the wazzapp group, and on the youtube channel. The formations are public and visible to everyone in the Live Formations sheet on the site to guarantee transparency of the game.

Private messages will not be accepted for the reasons listed above.

To modify a prediction, you must modify the choices entered in the form.

The insertion and modification will be blocked at the time of the deadline and it will no longer be possible to edit or insert new predictions.

The sheet with all the formations will be published online and will be updated practically in real time with the arrival of the results.

Players who join the game after the first week will receive a score equal to 50% of the average points achieved for each tournament in which they have not participated. This score will also be included in the special rankings.

Those who do not submit the prediction are entitled to receive the same amount of points that are due to new entrants.

If a prediction is cancelled because it does not reflect the criterion of the two mandatory ATPs and two mandatory WTAs, it will have a recorded score of 0 (zero).

7) WITHDRAWALS, DISQUALIFICATIONS OR DRAWBOARD CHANGES

To prevent withdrawals from this edition as much as possible, there will be no Fantatennis week in any week before the 4 slams.

In the event of a player withdrawing and being replaced by a lucky loser, the withdrawn player will not be replaced and will be worth 0 points in the tournament, while still avoiding the risk, if seeded, of going negative.

If, however, the withdrawal occurs during the tournament, the withdrawn player will be considered defeated and will be assigned the points of the round in which he/she left the tournament with related bonuses or penalties.

The player who is disqualified and punished with the cancellation of points from the association to which he/she belongs for the game will be considered eliminated and will be regularly assigned the points earned in the tournament.

In the event of a change of place in the draw, the player will still remain valid in the predictions, maintaining the band he/she had before the change with related bonuses or penalties. If the predictions extend to the first day of competition or beyond, the band changes will become effective and the predictions will have to be modified.

8) TOURNAMENT NOT COMPLETED

If a tournament is not concluded due to rain or other external factors, it will be considered null and all players will have a score of 0 (zero).

9) INCORRECT BEHAVIOUR ON YOUTUBE AND SOCIAL GROUPS AND NICK CHANGE

The participants in the game are required to behave correctly both in the comments on YouTube and in social groups. Offenses, blasphemies, threats and other incorrect behavior will first result in a warning, then definitive exclusion from the game itself.

During the season, the initial name with which the first prediction was sent must be maintained. Each different name will be considered a new user and will start again from 0 points.

10) RANKINGS

The method of assigning the prizes up for grabs includes two methods: the ranking path and the tournament path.

The general ranking will be calculated by counting the best 25 scores out of the 30 available before the finals. The first 8 will qualify for the ATP finals of the classic path.

QUALIFICATION FOR THE ATP FINALS AND FINAL PRIZES

RANKING PATH

The 8 qualified for the finals of the ranking path will choose their representative for the finals starting from the first ranked up to the eighth. If the fantasy tennis player still has the bonus option available in this tournament, he will have to play it.

Each victory in the groups is worth 200 points

The victory in the semifinal is worth 400 points

The victory in the final is worth 500 points

The points added together are added to the general ranking and the first three positions give the right to the prizes.

In the event of a tie at the end of the regular season and then the finals, the highest score in the 30 weeks of the season will be taken into account to determine the placement. In the event of a tie, the second highest score will be taken into account, then the third highest score, etc. etc. until the position is defined.

TOURNAMENT PATH

Another eight prizes up for grabs are awarded using a qualification method that is completely independent of the ranking. The following will qualify for the ATP finals:

The participant who has obtained the highest score at the Australian Open. In the event of a tie between two or more players, the first player to submit a prediction will be qualified.

The participant who has obtained the highest score at Roland Garros. In the event of a tie between two or more players, the first player to submit a prediction will be qualified. If the participant has already qualified from another slam, the first available non-qualified score will be taken into account.

The participant who has obtained the highest score at Wimbledon. In the event of a tie between two or more players, the first player to submit a prediction will be qualified. If he/she is already qualified from another slam, he/she will be deducted from the first available non-qualified score.

The participant who has obtained the highest score at the US Open, in the event of a tie between two or more players, the one who has sent the prediction first will be qualified. If he/she is already qualified from another slam, he/she will be deducted from the first available non-qualified score.

The participant who has obtained the most points in the “red slam” or by adding the scores of Monte Carlo, Barcelona, Madrid, Rome, and Roland Garros, if already qualified, the second in the special ranking will be taken into consideration, then the third, etc. etc., in the event of a tie in points, the position in the ranking will be valid.

The participant who has obtained the most points in the “American concrete” or by adding the scores of Indian Wells, Miami, Toronto, Cincinnati and the US Open, if already qualified, the second in the special ranking will be taken into consideration, then the third, etc. etc., in the event of a tie in points, the position in the ranking will be valid.

The participant who has obtained the most points in the indoor tournaments or by adding the scores of the weeks of Rotterdam, Shanghai, Tokyo, Basel and Vienna, Paris Bercy including any women's tournaments, if already qualified, the second in the special ranking will be taken into consideration, then the third etc. etc., in the event of a tie in points, the position in the ranking will be valid.

The eighth place goes to the participant who has collected with his own predictions the greatest number of titles in the ATP and WTA tournaments regardless of the category. Also in this case, if the person who is first is already qualified, the second, the third etc. will proceed. In the event of an even number of victories, the highest position in the ranking will count.

The eight qualified will be paired by drawing lots with the eight tennis players qualified for the ATP Finals.

The draw will be carried out in a place to be defined no later than the Friday before the start of the finals, in the presence of at least one fantasy tennis participant excluded from the finals to guarantee the correct execution of all operations.

WTA FINALS TOURNAMENT PATH

The following will be qualified for the WTA finals tournament path:

The highest score of the WTA 1000 DOHA week, in the event of a tie between two or more players, the first player to submit the prediction first will be qualified.

The highest score of the WTA 1000 DUBAI week or if already qualified, the first non-qualified score, in the event of a tie between two or more players, the first player to submit the prediction first will be qualified.

The highest score of the INDIAN WELLS week or if already qualified, the first non-qualified score,

in the event of a tie between two or more players, the first player to submit the prediction first will be qualified.

The highest score of the MIAMI week or if already qualified, the first non-qualified score, in the event of a tie between two or more players, the first player to submit the prediction first will be qualified.

The highest score of the MADRID week or if already qualified, the first non-qualified score, in the event of a tie between two or more players, the first player to submit the prediction first will be qualified.

The highest score of the ROME week or if already qualified the first non-qualified score, in case of a tie between two or more players the first one who sent the prediction first will be qualified.

The highest score of the TORONTO/MONTREAL week or if already qualified the first non-qualified score, in case of a tie between two or more players the first one who sent the prediction first will be qualified.

The highest score of the CINCINNATI week or if already qualified the first non-qualified score, in case of a tie between two or more players the first one who sent the prediction first will be qualified.

The eight qualified players will be paired by drawing lots with the eight tennis players qualified for the WTA Finals.

The drawing will be carried out in a place to be defined no later than the Friday before the start of the finals, in the presence of at least one fantasy tennis participant excluded from the finals to guarantee the correct execution of all operations.

GRAND SLAM CUP 2026

The four slams plus the two fantasy football leagues will qualify 16 participants for the Grand Slam Cup 2026. The tournament will be a knockout tournament, taking into account only the slam tournaments.

QUALIFICATIONS

1000 Shanghai 2025

1000 Paris Bercy 2025

The qualifying draw must be made in the week following the US Open 2025

DRAWING

2026 Australian Open Round of 16

2026 Roland Garros Quarterfinals

2026 Wimbledon Semifinals

2026 US Open Final

The player with the highest score in the match advances to the next round. In the event of a tie, the player with the lowest seed number advances to the next round. If the prediction is identical, same 8 tennis players chosen, the first one to submit the prediction goes through, the time recorded by the system is valid.

GRAND SLAM CUP QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

The first three classified of each Slam qualify for the Grand Slam Cup, if one or more qualifiers is already in the draw from previous slams, his place will be deducted from the first non-qualified of the slam in question.

The two winners of league A and B of the channel's fantasy football.

The first and second non-qualified of each slam, theoretically the 4th and 5th in the ranking, will play for the last two places in the draw in two qualifying rounds to be played in the weeks of Shanghai (first round) and Paris Bercy (final round). Each slam provides two qualifiers. If a

qualifier manages to qualify directly for the tournament in the subsequent slams, he or she will be replaced by the next highest fantasy tennis player in the ranking of the slam in which he or she had qualified for the qualifiers.

The draw for the draw will be carried out in the week preceding the 2026 Australian Open. If both participants in a first round match fail to submit a prediction, they will be replaced by the first valid prediction relating to their qualifying slam.

SEEDS AND DRAWING PROCEDURE FOR THE DRAWING OF THE DRAWING

SEEDS 1-4 The winners of each slam or their substitutes ordered in ascending order based on the score achieved in the slam in which they qualified.

SEEDS 5-8 The runners-up in each slam or their substitutes ordered in ascending order based on the score achieved in the slam in which they qualified.

SEEDS 9-12 The third-placed players in each slam or their substitutes ordered in ascending order based on the score achieved in the slam in which they qualified. who have qualified

4 REMAINING PLACES The two qualifiers from the qualifying tournament and the two winners of the A and B leagues of the fantasy tennis. The qualifiers will be indicated by the letter Q (qualifier) and two winners of the two Fantacalcio leagues with the letter W (Wild Card)

The draw will be structured as per the ATP rules for 16-seeded tournaments.

The same rules, except for the qualification, apply to the 2025 pilot edition.

MASTER TENNIS

MASTER TENNIS is an elimination tournament parallel to Fantatennis.

The first 34 in the ranking after the Australian Open participate in the game and in 26 weeks of play they will be reduced to 8 and paired by lottery with the 8 teams qualified for the Davis Cup finals.

If there are more players tied for position 34, all those with the same score enter the game.

Every week one participant is eliminated. The elimination table is as follows:

The best score of each Fantatennis game week, 1,16,24 excluded, will guarantee immunity for the following week.

The four slams instead will allow you to choose through the bye when to use immunity but will not guarantee immunity in the following week if not used.

The four worst of the week are at risk of elimination plus one chosen by the winner of the week. Of the five at risk, the one who will have the worst score in the following week will be eliminated.

Only for the first week, if the participants exceed 34, the lowest scores will be eliminated plus the one chosen by the best in the ranking in such a number that after the first elimination the number of participants is 33.

In case of failure to submit the prediction as per Fantatennis rules, the participant will obtain the guaranteed score. If there is a tie in scores, the score of the previous week will be taken into account to decide the eliminated player and the worst will exit the competition. In case of further tie, the worst in the ranking will be eliminated.

The use of the bye to save oneself must be declared by the end of the second round of the first tournament scheduled for the week.

The byes must however be used by the Shanghai Masters 1000.

The choice of the player at risk of elimination by the winner of the week must take place within the first day after the definition of the results and when it will be possible it must be done in the live YouTube dedicated to the game.

The draw for the pairing with the 8 Davis teams must take place by the Friday before the start of the competition.
